

Attachment A:

Infrastructure investment

The Government approved for more than \$1 billion to upgrade Reserve and Cadet facilities around Australia including in Rural and Regional areas over the next ten years.

By State:

- 10 sites in NSW at more than \$100m
- 1 site in ACT at more than \$20m
- 14 sites in VIC at more than \$200m
- 2 sites in SA at more than \$15m
- 2 sites in TAS at more than \$30m
- 8 sites in WA at more than \$110m
- 4 sites in NT at more than \$80m
- 14 sites in QLD at more than \$220m

note this only adds to \$775m because it is trade cost only. So it is a minimum spend figure plus contingency. There is \$85m for project development and management

This includes \$53m of infrastructure investment for 18 priority sites in 2022-23.

By State:

- 6 sites in QLD worth more than \$20.4m
- 6 sites in NSW worth more than \$10.8m
- 1 site in NT worth almost \$1m
- 1 site in SA worth over \$5.3m
- 1 site in VIC worth more than \$6.4m
- 2 sites in WA worth more than \$6.5m
- 1 site in TAS worth over \$2.7m

Locations include:

- Queensland: Townsville, Oakey, Bundaberg, Thursday Island;
- New South Wales: Nowra, Gosford, Inverell and Lismore;
- Western Australia: Coondanup;
- South Australia: Noarlunga, and
- Tasmania: Devonport.

Defence are exploring options to lease or build new facilities for four Cadet units located in:

- Queensland: Yeppoon
- New South Wales: Batemans Bay;
- South Australia: Ceduna, and
- Northern Territory: Katherine.
